



Travel to Corfu



Corfu Island is served by “Ioannis Kapodistrias” international airport (CFU) located in Corfu town. During the touristic season there are direct flights from many European towns to Corfu. During offseason most of the air traffic is primarily through Athens airport. You can check flights [HERE](#).



People who drive to Corfu from the Greek mainland need to get a ferry at Igoumenitsa port. There are frequent departures from early in the morning until late the evening and no reservation is required. There are also Ferries from Patras and from Italian ports like Brindisi, Ancona and Venice. More information about ferry tickets [HERE](#).

Directions to Akrotiri Hotel from the airport

As you leave the airport you make a right turn and drive for approximately 1 km until you reach the sea.



Then you turn left



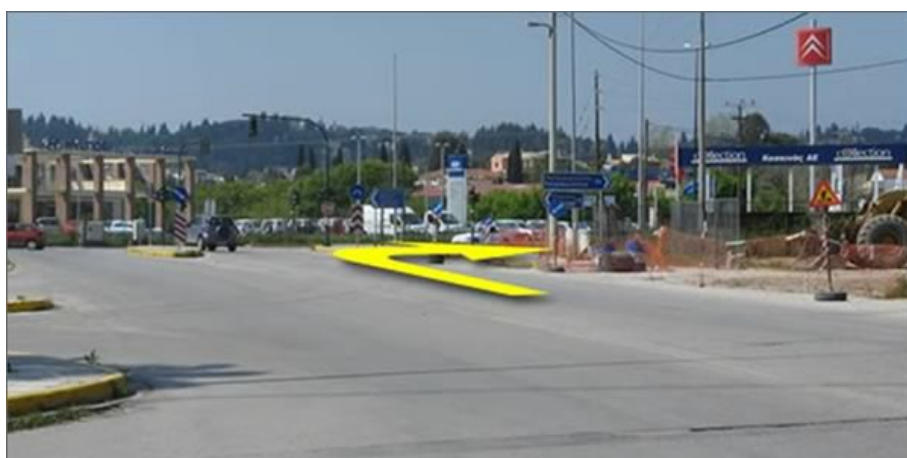
... and drive on the road which goes along the sea



This road leads you through and then out of the old Corfu town.



After you have passed by the old and the new port and a marina, (approximately 4 km) you will turn right on the traffic lights.



You are now on the main road that will take you straight ahead to Paleokastritsa.



After approximately 22km from Corfu town you will see our hotel's twin gates on the left of the road, at the end of a downhill followed by a sharp right turn. (Please pay attention to cars coming from the opposite direction as you turn left to enter the hotel parking).
